



Announcement from the Faculty of Economics, Chiang Mai University
Subject: Recruitment of Students for Teaching Assistant (TA) Grants
for Undergraduate and Postgraduate Courses,
Semester 1, Academic Year 2025

The Faculty of Economics, Chiang Mai University, is pleased to offer grants to undergraduate and postgraduate students to act as teaching assistants for undergraduate and postgraduate courses during semester 1 of the academic year 2025. Further details are outlined below.

1. Grant Titles and Details

1.1 TA5000

1.1.1 Undergraduate Assistants (751101)

- Remuneration Rate: 50 Baht per hour.
- Payment Process: Upon completion of every 100 hours of work, a performance report must be submitted (by filling in work details and hours on the Faculty's prescribed form).
- A grant of 5,000 Baht will be disbursed, with a maximum of two claims, up to a total grant value of 10,000 Baht.

1.1.2 Postgraduate Assistants (751701)

- Remuneration Rate: 100 Baht per hour.
- Payment Process: Upon completion of every 50 hours of work, a performance report must be submitted (by filling in work details and hours on the Faculty's prescribed form).
- A grant of 5,000 Baht will be disbursed, with a maximum of three claims, up to a total grant value of 15,000 Baht.

1.2 TA2500

1.2.1 Undergraduate Assistants (751101)

- Remuneration Rate: 50 Baht per hour.
- Payment Process: Upon completion of every 50 hours of work, a performance report must be submitted (by filling in work details and hours on the Faculty's prescribed form).
- A grant of 2,500 Baht will be disbursed, with a maximum of two claims, up to a total grant value of 5,000 Baht.

2. Grant Conditions

- 2.1 Undergraduate students must assist with undergraduate courses.
- 2.2 Postgraduate students must assist with undergraduate or master's level courses.
- 2.3 Assistants are required to perform their duties as Teaching Assistants throughout semester 1 of the academic year 2025.
- 2.4 Assistants must participate in Faculty activities or other assigned duties.

3. Number of Grants and Available Courses

3.1.1 TA5000 Grants

Undergraduate Course (751101): 11 grants available, up to a maximum of 10,000 Baht per grant.

Postgraduate Course (751701): 3 grants available, up to a maximum of 15,000 Baht per grant.

3.1.2 TA2500 Grants

Undergraduate Course (751101): 6 grants available, up to a maximum of 5,000 Baht per grant.

Note: The number and value of grants may be adjusted as deemed appropriate during the selection process. One TA5000 grant is equivalent to two TA2500 grants, provided the total allocated budget is not exceeded.

4. Applicant Qualifications

- 4.1 Must be a student of the Faculty of Economics, Chiang Mai University.
 - 4.1.1 Undergraduate Students: Must be in their second year or above, with a cumulative GPA of not less than 3.00.
 - 4.1.2 Postgraduate Students:
 - 4.1.2.1 Master's Degree Students: Must be in their second year or above, with a cumulative GPA of not less than 3.50.
 - 4.1.2.2 Doctoral Degree Students: No year status restriction, with a cumulative GPA of not less than 3.50.
- 4.2 Must be responsible, well-behaved, and strictly adhere to university rules and regulations.

5. Selection Process

Applicants will be selected through an interview process conducted by a committee appointed by the Faculty. The committee's decision will be final.

6. Application Period

- Application Submission: From 4th July 2025, at the Educational Service Affairs, Faculty of Economics, Chiang Mai University.
- Announcement of Interview Shortlist: 14th July 2025.
- Interviews: 16th July 2025.
- Announcement of Grant Recipients: 18th July 2025.
