

Thailand Scholarship 2025

Requirements, Terms and Conditions

1. Scholarship requirements

- Work as a teaching assistant (TA), research assistant (RA), faculty ambassador, or other assignments assigned by the master's program or graduate committees of the Faculty of Economics, Chiang Mai University.
- The student is required to have at least one Scopus publication in Economics and Econometrics subject area within the second year. The student must be the first author, and at least one co-author must be an advisor affiliated with the Faculty of Economics, Chiang Mai University. The publication must be relevant to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
- The student is required to get an approval of research proposal within the first year. This requirement is a condition for receiving continued scholarship support in the second year.

2. Payment Conditions of Monthly Allowance

A monthly allowance of 13,000 THB will be provided during the first 6 months. From the 7th month up to the 24th month, a monthly allowance of 8,000 THB per month will be provided. The rest of 90,000 THB will be paid in a lump-sum upon successful completion of graduation within 24 months but no later than 36 months.

3. Termination and Continuing the Scholarships

Students are obligated to reconfirm their eligibility annually to maintain their scholarship status. Scholarships may be granted for a maximum of two years. They will be revoked under the following conditions.

- Loss of student status at the Faculty of Economics, Chiang Mai University.
- Unable to fulfill the minimum work hours assigned by the master's program or graduate committees.
- Commit any fraudulent act concerning "Chiang Mai University Regulations Concerning Discipline and Student Disciplining B.E. 2553."
- GPA lower than 3.25 at the end of each academic year.
- The master's thesis proposal was not approved within one academic year.
- Any behavior that harms moral values, good traditions, or social norms, and breaks the law.
- Having received a report of poor academic progress from the advisor.
- Unable to live in Thailand due to the Laws, Rules, or Regulations of Thailand or any other reason.

4. This scholarship includes:

1) Travel expense:	10,000 THB/year (for 2 years)
2) Allowance and accommodation: *	2.1 month 1 – 6: 13,000 THB/month 2.2 month 7 – 24: 8,000 THB/month 2.3 graduation within 24 months but no later than 36 months: lump sum of 90,000 THB
3) Book and supplies:	4,000 THB/year (for 2 years)
4) Accident and health insurance:	5,000 THB/year (for 2 years)
5) Tuition Fee:	Waived
6) Visa Fee:	2,000 THB/Year (for 2 years)

Remark: * The conditions for receiving the payment are as specified in No. 2 payment condition of the monthly allowance
