Scholarship Program Update for FY 2025

 We will increase the scholarship amount per student to THB 50,000 to provide more substantial financial assistance.

However, due to funding limitations, we will **reduce the number of recipients** from 10 to **6**.

We appreciate your understanding.

 We fully respect the current selection criteria established by your university and the scholarship selection committee.

While it is perfectly acceptable to continue using the existing criteria, we would appreciate your consideration in prioritizing **Pro-Japan talents** in future selection processes.

d) Upon the receipt of the Notice of Grant Approval, Chiang Mai University will submit an Application for Payment to the Foundation.

e) Following the receipt of the Application for Payment, the payment will be made immediately by telegraphic transfer to the bank account designated in the Application for Payment.

f) Upon receipt of the funds, Chiang Mai University should submit a formal receipt to the Foundation.
